If you are unable to take care of these things during Locker Day, please plan to stop by the office immediately following drop off on the first day of school.

## MORE IMPORTANT DETAILS TO NOTE ABOUT LOCKER DAY

- \*6th grade students and parents be sure to plan to stay for "6th Grade Scoop" beginning at 6 PM that night (see article below).
- No school supplies are to be brought on Locker Day. School supplies are to be brought on the first day of school. (Exception: Early Ed students will bring their supplies to Early Ed Essentials at 6:00 PM.)

Lower School (K - 5th grade) and Early Ed classrooms will not be open on Locker Day. However, all classrooms will be open on Back-to-School Night (Tuesday, August 20).

# CURRICULUM NIGHT (K-12TH)

Curriculum Night is **Tuesday, August 27**. This **parents-only event** provides parents the opportunity to spend time with their

child's teachers and learn what to expect for the coming school year. To accommodate parents who have children in multiple grades, the evening has been split into two time slots.

Parents of students in grades K-5 should plan to come from 6:00-6:25 or 6:30-6:55. Go directly to your child's classroom at the start of one of these times to meet with your child's teacher and hear about the year ahead. The same material will be covered during both times, so it is only necessary to choose one time per student.

Parents of students in grades 6-12 should plan to come at 6:30. Parents will be given a copy of their child's schedule and will participate in a "mini version" of their day. With 10-minute periods, the "mini day" will end around 8:00.

Please remember that this event is for parents only. No students or younger siblings should be brought to this event.

#### MEDICAL

If your student has a chronic medical issue including but not limited to:

- Severe Allergies
- Asthma
- Diabetes

Physician-directed Action Plans and medication forms are due before the first day of school. Questions? Contact our school nurse, Mrs. McLain.

Parents are responsible for notifying the school if their student may need medical care or medication while at school. Stop by our medical table on Locker Day to talk to the nurse and to drop off medical forms. #### **EXTENDED CARE**

Before School Care will be available beginning the first day of school (Wednesday, August 21) for Early Ed— 5th grade. Students may arrive as early as 7:15 AM. Please escort K-5th grade students to Room 235 (the Art Room) and Early Ed students to room 132 and sign them in. Students are dismissed to classrooms at 8:00 AM. Please note: All Early Ed—5th grade students who arrive prior to 7:50 must be signed in to BSC. Students will not be allowed to wait in the airlock prior to 7:50. Upper School students (6th-12th) may arrive after 7:15 AM. Jr. High (6th-8th grade) students must report to the Forum Room until 7:50 AM (no charge).

After School Care will also begin on August 21. Any Early Ed—8th grade student not picked up by 3:30 PM will be escorted to Room 235 and signed in to ASC. Please remember to sign your student out when you pick them up, or a 5:30 sign-out time will be assumed.
