#### SCHOOL SUPPLY & SET-UP DAYS

## Thursday August 18th (8AM-3PM) & Monday, August 22nd (11AM-5PM)

Beginning today, families can access Sign-Up Genius to register for a time slot to deliver school supplies, pick up textbooks, and set up lockers on either Thursday, August 18, or Monday, August 22. Check out the information below for more information.

Students (1st—12th grade):

Drop off:



-School supplies (Kleenex, sanitizer, copy paper, antibacterial wipes, & baby wipes will be collected in the front hallway). All other school supplies will be placed on desks in classrooms (1st grade) or put in lockers (2nd—12th grade).

—Medication/Medical Forms

-Car information-make, model and license plate number (students driving to school)

Pick up:

—Car signs for dismissal (1st—8th grade)

-Textbooks (6th—12th grade)

Students in Early Ed and Kindergarten may sign up for a time slot or bring school supplies to Early Ed Essentials and Kindergarten Kick-Off. Medication/Medical Forms and car signs needed for dismissal can be dropped off or picked up that evening.

## 2nd-12th Grade Students Only:

Please put all school supplies in your locker and set up/ decorate your locker during your scheduled set-up time. See page 33 of the Parent/Student Handbook for information on permitted locker decorations. Be sure to check FACTS (available on Wednesday, August 17th) in order to know your locker assignment.

If you are unable to attend one of these days, your textbooks will be placed in your locker for you, and school supplies should be brought on the first day of school.



## CURRICULUM NIGHT (KINDERGARTEN-12TH)

Our annual Curriculum Night for parents only will be held Tuesday, August 30. Parents of students in grades K-5 should plan to attend from 6:00 - 6:25 PM or 6:30 -6:55 PM. Go directly to your child's classroom at the start of one of these times to meet with your child's teacher and hear about the year ahead. Parents of students in grades 6 - 12 should plan to come at 7:00 PM. Upper school parents will be given a copy of their student's schedule and will participate in a "mini version" of their day. With 10minute periods, the "mini day" will end around 8:30 PM.



#### **EXTENDED CARE**

Before School Care begins each day at 7:15 AM. All Early Education through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students arriving between 7:15 and 8:00 AM must report to the designated locations and be signed in by a parent or guardian upon arrival. Junior high students (6th - 8th grade) must go directly to the Upper Tiered Seating Area (UTSA) after they gather necessary items from their lockers. Upper School students are not invoiced for BSC. Students will not be allowed to wait in the airlock before school begins.

At 3:30 PM, all Early Ed-8<sup>th</sup> grade students who have not been picked up will be checked into After School Care. Parents/caregivers arriving to pick up students from After School Care must meet their children in the assigned ASC rooms and sign them out, recording the time of departure. Whenever circumstances require someone other than the child's custodial parents to pick him/her up from school or ASC, parents must inform school staff of such arrangements in advance, and photo identification of the approved caretaker may be requested. After School Care is available until 5:30 PM. See the Parent-Student Handbook on our website under **Quicklinks** for details about charges and billing.
