When: Saturday, November 9th 4:30 -6:30 PM (note new date and time!)

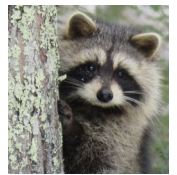
Cost: \$10 cash or check (payable to CCA) paid in advance in the office or \$10 at the door. *Please bring exact amount at the door.*
