

## STATE OF ILLINOIS STUDENT HEALTH RECORD REQUIREMENTS

Illinois law (105 ILCS 5/27-8.1 and 77 Illinois Administrative Code Part 665) requires students to submit the following health records **prior to attending** any public or private Illinois school at the grade levels listed below. Records must be current (dated within one year of the first day of school) and submitted on standard State of Illinois forms (available from your healthcare provider) **prior to the first day of school**.

12 <sup>th</sup> Grade	☐ Updated immunization record** providing documentation that the student has received a second dose of the meningococcal vaccine (MCV4).

## **IDPH Minimum Immunization Requirements to Attend School in Illinois**

Early Education (EE3/4, EE4/5, DK) Required Immunizations:

- DTap- 4 doses
- Polio- 3 doses
- MMR- 1 dose
- Varicella- 1 dose
- Hepatitis B- 3 doses
- Hib series (up to 4 shots) or one dose at 15 mos. or
- Pneumococcal series (up to 4 shots) or one dose at 24 mos. or older

Kdg through 5<sup>th</sup> grade Required Immunizations:

- DTap- 5 doses
- Polio- 4 doses
- MMR- 2 doses
- Varicella- 2 doses

6<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade Required Immunizations:

- All K-5<sup>th</sup> required immunizations plus...
- Hepatitis B- 3 doses
- Tdap- 1 dose on or after 11<sup>th</sup> birthday
- MCV4- 1 dose on or after 11<sup>th</sup> birthday

## 12<sup>th</sup> grade Required Immunizations:

- All K-5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> required immunizations plus...
- MCV4- 2<sup>nd</sup> dose (2 doses total)
